

## *My Star Report*

### The Chiron Video

I don't know how many times I've sat down to write about Chiron only to fall short of my own expectations until now. The topic of Chiron is so vast, so expansive, so deep, and so complex that words just seem to fail – for me – until recently. I've decided to include an introduction to Chiron in the book I'm writing about the monthly housing method I use for personal chart analysis and mundane analysis but will offer the basics here by video.

Chiron is considered a planetoid, an asteroid shaped object that orbits Saturn. And as it orbits Saturn it passes between Jupiter and Saturn and between Uranus and Saturn – effectively bridging Jupiter and Uranus. Chiron bridges the inner planets (the personal planets) with the extra-personal planets – Saturn, Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto.

The first 6 houses are in the bottom hemisphere of the natal chart, right? The 1<sup>st</sup> house through 5<sup>th</sup> house being completely personal, the 6<sup>th</sup> house offering us opportunity to make a connection with the Earth, Mother Earth, GAIA, the mass conscience. The polar of the 6<sup>th</sup> house being universal consciousness or cosmic conscience. Once we've made that connection with the Earth and are properly grounded there, have experienced that connection, then we are ready to journey on to experience, understand, and evolve through the higher octaves of the upper hemisphere of the wheel. Successful relationships with others in the 7<sup>th</sup> house, transformation and understanding the metaphysical in the 8<sup>th</sup> house, then moving on into the 9<sup>th</sup> house to understand higher divine wisdom and merge with the higher self. From there we are prepared to move into the 10<sup>th</sup> house. The pinnacle of the wheel. Pivotal point where we learn and experience structure. Where we can effectively give form and structure and solid physical and metaphysical meaning to our life if we have survived – if we have managed to successfully survived the climb to those heights. Then and only there can we see what's next. From there in the 10<sup>th</sup> house where we now understand the form and structure of our total experience, our life, our purpose, our destiny, our trials, tests, tribulations, strengths and weaknesses. We are ready to use the valuable teachings of Chiron to cross into the world of knowing without knowing how we know. Freedom from form and structure of the physical world into the higher harmonics of Uranus and the outer planets. Freedom from the constraints of this dense physical plane we're so bound to, and so used to – the gross energies. And by Chiron move on to truly experience knowing of the metaphysical Pluto, the divine knowledge of Uranus and the cosmic universal experience of the sub-conscious mind. The universal mind. The cosmic awareness and vision we find through Neptune – ruler of the 12<sup>th</sup> house.

Chiron guides us all in different ways and is the prime indicator in the natal chart of where and how we will individually help others to see and heal. We all have an opportunity to lift others and positively affect human kind. So where is Chiron in your chart? And what does it mean? Once we have those answers then we can seek to consider Chiron's aspect relationships to key energies like the illuminaries (Sun and Moon), the Dragon Head and Tail, the Hidden Dragon Head and Tail (dimensional relationships). And its vital relationship to the house it occupies. Its aspect to the outer planets is also important – Neptune, Uranus, and certainly Pluto. In my

personal opinion, Saturn's aspect can be extremely important to know as well. Just because Saturn is at the center of this orbit does not preclude it from being considered a vital part of the analysis. Sometimes we forget to take meaning from the energy at the center of aspected relationships.

If you don't know where Chiron is in your chart email me with your birth info and I'll tell you. Plus, you never know, the unique monthly housing system I use may reveal something new to you. Not so much the sign Chiron is in for you but possibly the house, which will make all the difference in the world and make more sense than what you've already been told by another astrologer. The monthly housing system I use sometimes reveals to the native a perspective that makes much more sense than the Koch system or the Placidus system. I've found Louis Turi's monthly housing system to be the most accurate place to start. From there, I use methods that are multi-dimensional rather than just 2 dimensional. Focusing not so much on personality, likes and dislikes, mommy and daddy issues or issues with authority or career; but my focus usually digs deep into matters of your evolutionary path, your journey, the soul's journey, destiny as it relates to how you can find freedom in giving to the world what the universe intends for you to have the natural talent to give. Where can you find grounding? Where can you find balance in the 4 bodies – emotional, physical, mental, and spiritual balance. How can you find these things and how can you lift the veil to see more clearly and achieve greater spiritual acuity. How can you positively activate the more difficult aspects of your chart rather than continue to allow them to negatively impact your life. Because more than likely you already know those basic things about yourself like what's your personality like, how does the world perceive you, what kind of career field you should be in, right? The mundane things repeated to you by a software program are interesting and can certainly be useful for many purposes, but I have a tendency to approach a personal reading from the perspective of how you can move forward to merge with the higher self and achieve higher awareness and cosmic consciousness. For me, that's what astrology is all about now, here in the new age as we move forward into an understanding of the 5<sup>th</sup> dimension. But science is starting to see the 5<sup>th</sup> dimension leading us quickly into needing a 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> dimension to really explain some of the anomalies they're investigating. As we move away from the confinement of 3<sup>rd</sup> dimension understanding of mass and 4<sup>th</sup> dimension time limitations of quantum models limit experiencing and knowing the subquantum mind and the subquantum world. We can move into Holographic concepts of understanding the universe and ourselves. We can finally move into the Holographic experience that awaits us. If you're not already doing it, trust me, you can. It's what we're supposed to be doing now. The Holographic model of science isn't something new, it's just been suppressed. This is the direction in which we're being nudged. Uranus, the genius energies, the extraordinary, innovation, brilliance, epiphany, revelation, the universal mind, the advanced mind. How can we ever understand our place in the universe if we don't understand the universe itself? And how can we ever understand the universe until we connect with our higher self through GAIA consciousness by grounding ourselves with consciousness of the world we live in, the living, breathing, pulsating, evolving consciousness of the earth itself. We're getting deep into territories that are too time consuming to discover here in this video, but you see where I'm going. Chiron makes these 6<sup>th</sup> house issues clear to us so we can move into the upper hemisphere of our chart, and through diligent work and absolute attention we can quiet the mind and tune in to the subtle energies that have been masked for so long by the gross energies of 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> dimension limitations. We must move toward the understanding that we can blow up the deliberately institutionalized mental structure we've been

unfairly shackled to and enjoy the freedom of higher levels of awareness. This is the energy of Uranus, right? Explosive change. Aquarius, the new age. The awakening. The dawning of the age of Aquarius is over. The age itself is now here. We're in it. Uranus moves into Aries May 28 to give us a taste of that. Not a big taste because it will still be in the Void of Aries, but at least a little taste. Then Uranus goes Retrograde moving back into Pisces until it goes Direct again December 6, moves back into Aries Void March 12, 2011 and fully into Aries at 1 degree March 30, 2011 staying in Aries until it moves into Taurus in June of 2018.

Let's take my own chart for example. My Chiron is in Pisces in the 9<sup>th</sup> house. The 9<sup>th</sup> house is what? The higher self and seeking truth and higher wisdom. Chiron pushed me in that direction' it has for my whole life, every step of the way energetically compelled me to see divine truth and wisdom – even as a child – spending hours and days and years in the forests of rural north western Maryland experiencing nature's incredible energies that were there, even communing with the ancient residual energies of the native ones that lived there – the Mattaponi tribe and their neighbors. The Turtle people, the Potomac Indians and their Delaware brothers. Also the natives of the Virginia territories. The birds, the turtles, the waters. The trees, the frogs, raccoons, snakes, honeysuckle, sunflower, tobacco. The soil, Earth, GAIA. The nearby bays and oceans, the sands, sea life. The wild ponies of Assateague. They all speak the truth of creation to the quiet mind. These energies are the subtle energies that one can tune into. I was fortunate enough to migrate west to New Mexico and learn more about the Native American way and communion with nature and our four legged friends and our winged friends. The spirit world and the resonant energies of our ancient mother's and father's. That's just my experience though and yours may be entirely different of course. The stars provide each of us unique options, unique opportunities. But Chiron in the 9<sup>th</sup> house allowed me to tune in to those energies. Watching my father be so aware of those energies was also a subtle confirmation for me that these energies were real. My father was my authority figure – Saturn – and Saturn in my chart is also in the 9<sup>th</sup> house, closely aspected. Relationship by aspect – important. Virgo in the 3<sup>rd</sup> house – the polarized house – ensured me the option to commune with nature (Virgo) – to communicate (3<sup>rd</sup> house) with nature. The tools to help me deeply investigate, explore, and transform what I came to know through my experiences are Pluto and Uranus in that polarized 3<sup>rd</sup> house. Uranus is there with Pluto to help me communicate telepathically with nature. Relationship – you see how that works? Then Uranus in the 3<sup>rd</sup> house gives me the option to not only communicate my knowledge (9<sup>th</sup> house polarity) but to be able to use advanced technology to do it. And what am I doing now? Communicating to you electronically (Uranus) through the internet – advanced technology (Uranus). Pouring that information out to a thirsty world because Uranus rules Aquarius the water bearer pouring higher knowledge out onto a thirsty world. Midheaven for me is in Aquarius by the system I use. This is extradimensional astrology. On all levels follow the energies where they lead you in the chart. Look for all the relationships you can find between the energies in your chart. That's what makes a good reading. Midheaven in the 8<sup>th</sup> house is my opportunity for personal power and magnetism – what is it that will draw people to me magnetically? It's going to be my knowledge and understanding of these things...nature, GAIA, Earth consciousness and how to experience that, how to find that. How to understand that and how to use all that knowledge and understanding to transcend, right? 8<sup>th</sup> house transcendence into the 9<sup>th</sup> house of self-awareness. Connection with the higher self in the 9<sup>th</sup> house. Chiron in the 9<sup>th</sup> house.

I'm a Pisces in the 9<sup>th</sup> house – Chiron in Pisces – wow. What a trip, right? Because Pisces is ruled by Neptune and Neptune rules the astral plane, it rules the 12<sup>th</sup> house. This is the plane where people see and develop their ideas for art, music, movies, pictures, books, stories. This is the dimension of visualization where we can take an idea and prepare it for crystallization. Create the reality of it on this dense physical plane we live in. The physical is where we manifest, where we create and give physical life to these sounds and these visions and these ideas on the physical plane. The astral is where we dream them up, where we dream of what to create. In my opinion this is the most difficult energy of all to understand. The astral plane isn't exactly something we learn about in school, right? Of course not. As a matter of fact, a lot of people even laugh at you if you bring up the subject. The astral world, the ethers, right? The dimension where ideas begin to take shape. Where ideas become a vision, take on color, feeling, spiritual inspiration and universal meaning. Where possibilities and imagination exist. Neptune rules the imagination, fantasy, possibility for reality. Neptune rules the sub-consciousness. Terence McKenna talked about the aboriginals of Australia as describing the astral world as the dream world, the dream world being the un-conscious world and the un-conscious world being the real world. Not this dense physical world of consciousness or mass consciousness being real, but the sub-consciousness being real, the unconsciousness being real, the universal or cosmic conscience having more real meaning. And the 12<sup>th</sup> house is ruled by these energies. The 12<sup>th</sup> house is the last house of the wheel – it's what we seek to finally understand and find our connection to god there. God, source, the universe, creator, whatever you call it personally, you know what I mean.

There are many of you with Chiron in Pisces I know. Many of you. I've had a lot of clients with Chiron in Pisces. The meaning there is to find the relationship to god. Whatever that looks like to you, experience that connection, then help others find that for themselves. Guide them to that connection. I'm lucky my grandfather understood the astral world and the astral plane and was willing to confirm for me that reality. My grandfather was another solid figure of authority in my life. Again, Saturn authority – closely aspected to Chiron in Pisces in the 9<sup>th</sup> house in my chart. Relationship by aspect.
